



TEFL International Seville Frequently Asked Questions

1. What does the tuition for the program include?

Total course fees: 500 USD deposit paid directly to TEFL International
and
1148 Euro paid directly to TEFL Seville for course with accommodation
-or-
848 Euro paid directly to TEFL Seville for course without accommodation

*Please note that the course fee does not include flights, meals or other living expenses.

2. How do I pay for the course?

On the first morning of the course the trainers will arrive early to handle final payments. All payments must be made by the first day unless special arrangements have been made in advance.

The payment can be made:

- Cash upon arrival.
- Via PayPal.
- By bank transfer (which must be arranged with your bank before you leave home). If you would like to pay by bank transfer, please contact us for our bank details.

Late fees of 25€ per day may be assessed if payment is not made. Please note that if you choose to pay by bank transfer you must add the transfer fees to the tuition balance. If payments have not been received by the end of class Wednesday afternoon of the first week, you must receive permission from TEFL International Seville to remain in the course.

3. Who are the TEFL TESOL International Seville staff?

Dawn Risk: Course Director; manages academic side of the course. Teaches phonology as well as numerous teaching techniques. Coordinates teaching practices for TEFL students.

David Whitlock: Trainer; teaches grammar inputs along with numerous teaching techniques.

Johanna Nilsson: Coordinator of the program; manages administrative and financial side of the course including student correspondence and accommodations.

4. Where is the course held?

The course is held in our offices located in the historic Jewish neighborhood of Santa Cruz. We're located in a recently renovated historic building with all the facilities the TEFL students will need. The TEFL program shares this school with other foreign students studying a year abroad in Spain. There is a large park nearby along with many cafes, banks, shops and

historic sites to see.

5. What is an average program day like?

The course is an intense, challenging and fun experience. The school day is from 09.00 until 15.00 (Schedule may change). You will be taught grammar, phonology, lesson planning and various teaching techniques, along with giving group and private lessons. (See course content).

6. How many students on average are in the program each month?

On average we have from six to ten students enrolled in each program, most of whom are American or British.

7. What are the students and classes like with whom I'll be doing my teaching practicum?

Our practice students are adults of all ages and professions. They usually stay on from course to course and form good relationships with the TEFL trainees and staff.

8. What are the program accommodations like? Where are they located?

The accommodations are in 3 or 4 bedroom apartments. You will share the rooms (unless you want a single room), with two other trainees as roommates. The flats are comfortable and simply furnished. The kitchens are equipped with basic cooking utensils, stoves, refrigerators and washing machines. Blankets and sheets are provided, but bath towels are not. The flats are not equipped with either air conditioning or heating, like most homes in southern Spain. In winter, it is actually often much colder inside the houses than out. Please bring appropriate clothes for cold or hot weather and appropriate coverage for the evenings.

Each location is well-equipped with grocery stores, pharmacies, restaurants, bars, and shops. They are well-connected with the city centre, city bike routes, and several direct bus lines to the main city square. City buses are used by everyone in Seville. They are safe, affordable and easy to use.

9. When are the school accommodations available?

Our accommodations are available from the Saturday before the first day of the course to the Saturday after the last day of the course. Our pick-up service is only on the Saturday or Sunday before the first day of the course, so please make your travel plans accordingly.

10. Can I bring my laptop?

It is definitely a good idea for you to bring your laptop along with a pen drive as it will be a useful tool for your daily work.
